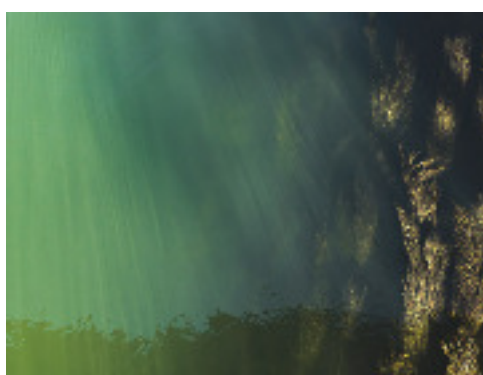

Assemble Plus project started

Marine biological stations have offered services and biological resources to science for more than a century. ASSEMBLE Plus will activate important research resources and provide scientists from academia, industry and policy with a quality-assured programme of access to the marine biology and ecology research infrastructure. The sum of the actions envisaged in ASSEMBLE Plus will increase the number of users of marine biological stations and shape their business strategy perspective, ultimately improving their long-term sustainability perspectives. Over 50 participants representing 32 organisations and 14 countries came together in Paris, France, from 19 - 20 October 2017, for the kick-off meeting of the ASSEMBLE Plus project.
